When we read this parable about perseverance, we may think that God is the judge and we are the widow, pestering God until we are given what we want. But what happens if we turn it around and say that we are the judge and God is the widow?

We, like the judge, are basically unjust. Sometimes we too have no fear of God or respect for man! We do not listen to God and refuse to listen to the cries of the poor all around us.

But God is the persistent widow who is constantly mindful of us, who badgers us, refusing to accept our no to love, who will persist until we render a just judgement, that is, until we let God's goodness out, until we learn to love. In Genesis we are told we are made in the image and likeness of God.

Perhaps our prayer could be: Dear God, Persevering One, make us more like you!
